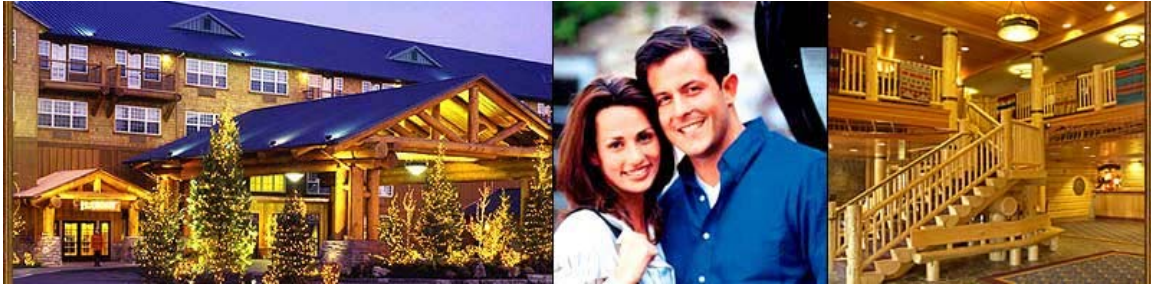


Save the Dates!

LODGING RESERVATIONS

Make your reservations now! The block of rooms for our conference is now open. Room rates are \$110.00 and \$10/person per night for each extra person (taxes not included). Business Level Guestrooms are \$125. Please call 1-888-4754-3100 to make your reservations. Don't forget to say you are with the Washington Municipal Clerks Association for the conference rates. **You must make your reservation prior to February 28, 2011** to receive the special rate. To help ease your budget, share a room and transportation with another clerk. Call your PD or conference buddies and share expenses.

These rates do not include the Vancouver City Occupancy Tax of 10.2% and a \$2.00 per room, per night County Assessment or any other fees imposed by the City or State at the time of our meeting.

The hotel is just 5 minutes from the Portland Airport. The hotel has a shuttle available for \$8 per person per trip. 10-day minimum advanced reservations are required. Same-day shuttle requests cannot be guaranteed. For reservations, please contact shuttle@heathmanlodge.com.

There are many activities nearby for your free night. We are exploring the possibility of an optional event again for this conference. More information will be provided at a later date.

The largest mall in southwest Washington, Westfield Vancouver mall, is nearby. It provides more than 140 shops and department stores such as Nordstrom, Macy's, J.C. Penney and Sears. There is also a food court and old-fashioned carousel for the little ones (or young at heart.)

Pearson Air Museum (www.pearsonairmuseum.org) provides a display of aviation history. The exhibition area offers a stunning collection of vintage airplanes, interpretive displays, an interactive children's center, theater presentations and gift shop.

Big Al's (www.ilovebigals.com) was voted as Clark County's best family fun value in 2008 and 2009. It is a huge entertainment complex offering 30 lanes of bowling and another 12 lanes in an intimate lounge-style setting. There are over 100 player positions at the video arcades. Big Al's Sports Bar and grill boasts a monster 8'x36' wide jumbo-tron video screen to broadcast all the games.

Cinetopia/Vinotopia (www.cinetopiatheaters.com) provides a variety of high-end entertainment options under one roof. The movie theaters have superior seating. Within Cinetopia is Vinotopia, a friendly. Upscale American Grill and wine bar with indoor and tropical garden seating. The wine bar has a fully-automated tasting system where you can sample from over 100 different wines from around the world. An optional event may be scheduled for conference attendees.
